In-Person Worship Gathering Protocols

Revised by the Session on August 16, 2021

Due to the increase of Covid cases in Nueces County because of the new Covid Delta Variant, the Session is implementing the following protocols for In-Person Worship.

- Worship services will continue to be broadcast on Zoom.
- **In-Person Attendance** the following will be observed:
 - Please do not enter the building until you are ready to be seated.
 - Masks Everyone must wear a mask at all times while in the sanctuary. This is to protect everyone in attendance, especially children who are not yet vaccinated, those who have not yet received the vaccine, and even those who are vaccinated.
 - **Hand Sanitizer** Please use hand sanitizer as you enter the building and as often as you feel necessary.
 - Social Distancing.
 - Sit only with people in your family.
 - Assure there is an empty bench in front and in back of you.
 - Assure no one is sitting directly in back or in front of you or your family.
 - **Physical Contact** Before, during, and after the service, **refrain** from any physical contact except with your own family (*e.g., no hugs, no handshakes, etc.*).
 - Singing Sing in your heart, not with your voice. DO NOT REMOVE YOUR MASK!
 - Lord's Supper For the Lord's Supper, maintain social distancing when coming forward to receive the elements assuring safety protocols in mind.
 - **Offering** Place your offering in the designated spot as you enter the sanctuary, or at your convenience. You may still mail your offering if you wish.
 - After Worship When worship concludes, please take a moment to wipe down any hard surface you might have touched. Please exit the sanctuary in a manner that maintains social distance. Due to the high increase in Covid cases, we highly recommend no gatherings or conversations be held outside!
- If you are feeling sick (or have been sick recently), please do not attend worship in person.
- **COVID** If you have symptoms of Covid-19, including a fever of over 100.4 *OR* have Covid DO NOT ATTEND WORSHIP SERVICES. Contact the clerk of session, Andy Anzaldua (361-877-1590 or via e-mail, <u>andyanzaldua@gmail.com</u>), and let him know so that the Session can assess what measures to take for in-person services which may include closing the church.
- No gatherings will be allowed in the narthex or Fellowship Hall.
- The church will be open only for Sunday worship. No other gatherings on church property will be held at this time unless approved by the Session.
- Attendance will be kept to mark your presence with us (*also in the event that contact tracing is needed*).
- Your health and well-being remain our utmost concern!
